



Free Time Activities and Present Simple Positive he / she / it

(Szabadidős tevékenységek és állítás egyszerű jelenben ő (hímnem) / ő (nőnem) / az (semlegesnem))

We use the present simple in English for activities that people regularly do or are normally true.

(Az egyszerű jelent az angol nyelvben a rendszeres cselekvések kifejezésére használjuk, vagy olyan dolgok megnevezésekor, melyek általánosan igazak.)

Spelling rules for Present Simple he / she / it

<p><i>Most Verbs: add –s</i> (A legtöbb ige –s végződést kap)</p>	<p><i>Verbs ending in –ch, –sh, –s, –ss, –x, –z:</i> add –es (Ha az ige –ch, –sh, –s, –ss, –x, –z végződésű, akkor –es toldalékot kap.)</p>

He / She / It **works**

He / She / It **watches**

He / She / It **misses**

*Verbs **go** and **do**: add –es*

Verbs ending in consonant +y: add –ies

He / She / It **goes**

He / She / It **studies**

He / She / It **does**

He / She / It **marries**

*Verb **have** is irregular*

He / She / It **has**
