



## Past Simple Negative

(Egyszerű múlt, tagadás)

To make the past simple negative, we use „subject + didn't + infinitive“:

(Az egyszerű múlt tagadó formájának kifejezése: alany + didn't + főnévi igenév)

<b>Subject</b> (Alany)	<b>Past Simple Positive</b> (Egyszerű múlt, kijelentés)	<b>Past Simple Negative</b> (Egyszerű múlt, tagadás)
<b>I</b>	worked	<b>didn't</b> work
<b>You</b>	worked	<b>didn't</b> work
<b>He</b>	worked	<b>didn't</b> work
<b>She</b>	worked	<b>didn't</b> work
<b>It</b>	worked	<b>didn't</b> work
<b>We</b>	worked	<b>didn't</b> work
<b>They</b>	worked	<b>didn't</b> work

For **short answers** in the past simple, we use:

(A rövid választ egyszerű múltban a következő módon fejezzük ki: )

Yes, I/you/he/she/it/we/they did

No, I/you/he/she/it/we/they didn't

### Exercise 1: Re-write the following sentences using the past simple negative.

(1. feladat: Írjátok újra a következő mondatokat úgy, hogy az egyszerű múlt tagadó alakját használjátok.)

1. I went on holiday last year > **I didn't go on holiday last year.**
2. You wrote a book when you were 22 > You didn't write a book when you were 22.
3. I had a pet > I didn't have a pet
4. We ate dinner 10 minutes ago > We didn't eat dinner 10 minutes ago.
5. He bought a DVD yesterday > He didn't buy a DVD yesterday.
6. She went shopping at the weekend > She didn't go shopping at the weekend.

7. They knew many people in London > They didn't know many people in London.
8. We stayed in a hotel > We didn't stay in a hotel.
9. You met a friend on Sunday > You didn't meet a friend on Sunday.
10. He slept for 10 hours last night > He didn't sleep for 10 hours last night.
11. I told my friend a good story > I didn't tell my friend a good story.
12. He took lots of photos > He didn't take a lot of photos.
13. We cooked a fantastic meal > We didn't cook a fantastic meal.
14. I read a magazine > I didn't read a magazine.
15. She taught the children for a year > She didn't teach the children for a year.
