

Digital Practices for Inclusive Programs Our project, Digital Practices for Inclusive Programs, is an Erasmus+ KA2 project that aims to promote digital pedagogies in integration & educational programs to ultimately create more inclusive programs for migrants with special needs. The objectives of this 24 month project are: i) to develop an innovative program based on existing digital tools that focuses on individuals specific needs, thus creating high-quality, inclusive programs ii) to enhance trainers/advisers digital competences; these newly learned skills will be validated through badge/certifications iii) to improve digital competences of migrants through an online course that is tailor-made to their needs; a participatory approach based on ICT-methods will enhance their inclusion and thus, encourage a sense of belonging in the local community iv) to transfer these sample programs to apply them to other services (educational, social, etc).
